A deposit of \$100 per week per camper, using a MasterCard, Visa or eCheck payment, is required with each application. This year, families are asked to pay in full or to pay in monthly installments over 6 months. Payment plans can also be arranged. Unless you are waiting to hear back about financial aid, **50% of your balance is due by Sunday, March 15. Full payment is due by May 15, 2026.**

REFUND POLICY

We must have notification in writing if you find it necessary to withdraw your child before the start of camp. We will then refund your payment less the following administrative fees:

Through January 15	*NEW* \$50 fee for withdrawing completely; <u>No penalty</u> for modifying registration
January 16 to March 15	15% of tuition of any cancelled session
March 16 to May 15	50% of tuition of any cancelled session
After May 15	No refund available

SCHOLARSHIPS

Sources of possible financial aid include your synagogue and local Jewish Federation. Consult your Rabbi or Federation regarding funding. As a supplement to this assistance, scholarships are available from Ramah New England. Scholarship applications will be made available to registered camp families in mid-November and are due back by Thursday, February 12. Scholarship award notifications will be emailed by late March.
