



## **Rosh Sport (Sports Head)**

### **Job Description:**

The Rosh Sport is a member of the senior leadership team and oversees a dedicated group of sports specialists and counselors. This position is responsible for creating and running a dynamic and well-rounded sports program that includes archery and the climbing tower, along with traditional sports (e.g., soccer, flag football, volleyball) and team-building activities.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Lead short *kvutzah* (bunk) activities in the morning, giving campers exposure to a variety of sports.
- Manage two chug (elective) sessions in the afternoon throughout the week for campers who want to explore specific sports in greater depth.
  - During each elective block, 4–6 different sport electives run simultaneously.
  - Create weekly staffing schedules.
  - Determine which sports will be offered during each session.
- Maintain a safe, organized, and well-run activity area.
- Order sports supplies and equipment as needed.
- Oversee a staff of approximately five sports specialists during the day and counselors during elective blocks.
- Encourage curiosity, creativity, teamwork, and positive sportsmanship among campers.
- Assist in planning and implementing Yom Sport (Color War).

### **Qualifications:**

- Interest in sports
- Enjoys working with children in active, creative environments
- Strong communication and organizational skills
- Ability to lead engaging, hands-on activities
